Head coach of Hofstra Univ. softball team - led Hofstra to regional finals in '04 & '05 - captured 9 straight conference titles from 1998-2006 - Named 7 times as Regional Coach of the Year - has led Hofstra program to national prominence. Elected to the Softball Hall of Fame in 2009.

Head coach of University of South Florida - Asst. coach of USA Pan Am gold medal team - Asst. coach of USA gold medal team at ISF World Championship - Head coach of USA gold medal Pan Am qualifier team - coached USA Junior men's team in ISF World Championship - ASA National Champion with Tampa Smokers - 1991 silver medalist at Pan Am Games.



Leslie King
Head Coach
Univ. of Penn.

Since her arrival at Penn, has coached 25 All-Ivy players & led the Red and Blue to their 1st Ivy League South Division title in '07. Head coach at George Washington Univ. where she was instrumental in developing softball into a varsity sport for its inaugural season in '03. Asst. softball coach at Lock Haven Univ. For 14 years, King was the starting shortstop for the New Zealand National softball team & served as captain of the squad that won the silver medal at the World Championship.



Jay Nelson

Jay Nelson began his first season as the head coach of the Scarlet Knights. Nelson recently completed his 10th season as the top asst. coach at Seton Hall Univ. He helped guide the pirates to the Big East Conference Championships in '04 & '05 and runner-up finishes in '99 & '01.

Syracuse Univ.

Head coach of Syracuse University since '07. Ross completed 8 seasons as head coach of Bowling Green University where she became the coach with the most wins in school history. She turned BGSU into a perennial Mid-American contender. Her '04 team posted the first MAC Tournament title in the school's history.



Eileen Schmidt
Head Coach
Univ. of Virginia

Head coach Eileen Schmidt returned to her alma mater in June '07 and currently is in her first season at the helm of the Cavalier softball program. Schmidt, a native of Barto, PA, competed for Virginia from '91-'94. She was the first Cavalier softball player to earn All-ACC honors 3 times ('92, '93 & '94) and became UVA's first All-American. Schmidt was the head coach at Kentucky from '05-'07 and at Northwestern State in '03 & '04.
